

SIMPLE AND COMPLEX LOCKOUT TAGOUT

OSHA estimates that over 50,000 injuries and 120 fatalities occur in the work place each year due to locking and tagging out equipment improperly or not at all. This breakout session will review the requirements for both Simple and Complex Lock Out /Tag Out (LOTO). Most importantly we will discuss LOTO near misses, hidden hazards, and lessons the presenter has learned over the last 30 years in the pharmaceutical industry.

This is a great short course for managers, supervisors, maintenance workers, and production workers. Each attendee is guaranteed to increase their hazard recognition and make their Lock Out /Tag Out program more robust.
